

Surgical Scars, Mesotherapy and Biomesotherapy®

All scars of all types (both mucous and skin) but in particular, this article deals with, those from surgery, both mucous and skin, must be treated with Mesotherapy and even more effectively with Biomesotherapy®.

The surgical scar has the characteristic of being sudden, abrupt, unexpected for the system which can react even in an anomalous way:

- not recognizing her and therefore altering late or deforming healing procedures (torpid scars, abnormal due to slow recovery),
- misunderstanding their nature and accelerating, exaggerating them, the repair processes, thus giving rise to a deformation due to excess (keloid) which certainly does not have to be further treated with a surgical revision which would risk producing the same result again or worsening given the repetition of the trauma and further alteration of the repair tissue,
- emission of anomalous messages, due to lack of central recognition, which risk (Neuraltherapy) creating anomalous impulses (disturbing fields) which, when brought to the organs, in the most varied of ways, alter their functioning, generating symptoms that are most often incomprehensible and then resolved by treatment with Mesotherapy and Biomesotherapy® of scars.

Contemporary multi-injection (sterile, disposable multi-injectors, with various numbers of nozzles) (multi-injection is the cornerstone of this type of treatment) of the scar must be repeated until it proves to be completely regenerated until it is even completely re-epithelized (a phenomenon that is far from uncommon).

The drugs that will be used, together with the classic Procaine 2% diluted to 20 cc physiological in the Allopathic version, will be those that promote skin trophism and those known for their repairing action. Even more desirable is the use of Homeopathic Remedies injectable alone or in complexes with Biomesotherapy® which give an absolute guarantee of lack of side effects and an excellent therapeutic response which, in this case, is not only local in the scar area but, due to the peculiar properties of the Remedies used, it becomes a general etiological action to correct not only the recognition of the injured area but the dynamics of control of the altered repair by promoting the correct very thick recovery action up to complete restitutio ad integrum.

Multi injection Mesotherapy is today a knowledge that must become public knowledge in the Medical and Nursing fields and be accepted as a normal practice in the parenteral administration of drugs, undoubtedly superior in speed and quality to intravenous medication.
